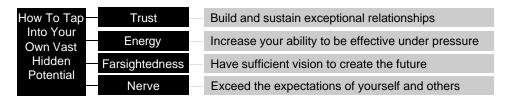

MAIN IDEA

Human beings only ever use a fraction of the potential power of their personal intelligence and spirit – 10% or probably much less.
